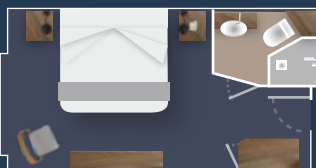

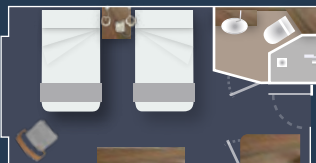

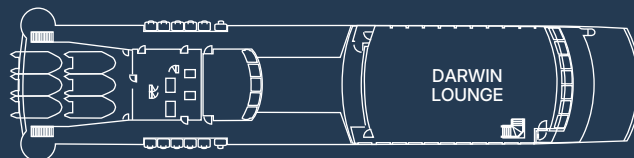

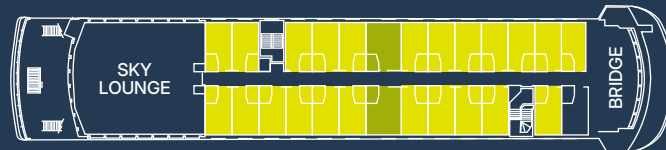

Patagonia can experience all four seasons in a day, so we recommend dressing in layers, wearing waterproof outer layers, as everything can change within minutes!

- Fleece and thermal base layer

On board, The dress code is casual; there's no need for formal attire at any time.

Pack wisely, as we do not have laundry facilities on board.

Bring a supply of any medications you may need.

We are far away from any pharmacies and even in Punta Arenas and Ushuaia, you may not find what you need.

Our cabins are equipped with 220-volt outlets. In the bathrooms, the outlets are 110 volts.

PRICING CONDITIONS

FOR THE 2027 - 2028 SEASON

+ TICKET CONTRACT

The ticket contract shall be issued by the ship operator prior to the vessel's departure. The ticket contract is governed by the provisions published on the Company's website (www.australis.com), which the holder of the reservation declares to understand and accept along with the reservation, in accordance with these pricing conditions. These pricing conditions also govern the ticket reservation made by the passenger, where appropriate. The terms "the Company" or "the Ship Operator" refer to either Transportes Marítimos Geo Australis S.A. or Transportes Marítimos Via Australis S.A., determined by the vessel on which the reservation is made and which will be the carrier of the reserved voyage, as confirmed by the corresponding issued ticket.

+ RATES AND DEPARTURES

The Company reserves the right to modify the rates and departures published in these pricing conditions without prior notice, which will be valid from the date of publication.

+ CHECK-IN, BOARDING, DEPARTURE AND ARRIVAL

Boarding, departure, and arrival times are approximate. Passengers must comply with the check-in schedule and show up at the required times. Check-in, boarding, departure and arrival times may be delayed due to weather conditions, by order of the maritime authority, for sanitary measures adopted by the Company or put in place by the authorities due to the welfare, health and safety of one or more passengers or due to an act of authority or other event constituting force majeure or a fortuitous event. The Company shall not be liable and affected passengers shall not be entitled to any compensation in these circumstances. Likewise, in case of the delayed arrival of the vessel, the Company may need to delay the check-in, boarding and departure of the ship on the next trip. The Company will not be liable for any loss resulting from such delays and will not be required to compensate the affected passengers.

+ INCLUDED IN THE PRICE

Rates include accommodation, sea transportation, all meals, open bar at set times (includes the entire bar menu, without exclusions), shore excursions and available onboard activities.

+ NOT INCLUDED IN THE PRICE

Travel Insurance. Gratuities (US\$25 per person per night is recommended), purchases from the onboard store, optional tours or activities outside the Australis itinerary, transfers in Punta Arenas

or Ushuaia and any immigration fees. Also not included in the price are government port fees, taxes and national park fees (boarding taxes) which for the 2027-2028 season are as follows:

Punta Arenas to Ushuaia itinerary: US\$160 per person.

Ushuaia to Punta Arenas itinerary: US\$160 per person.

Punta Arenas to Ushuaia to Punta Arenas itinerary: US\$185 per person.

Ushuaia to Punta Arenas to Ushuaia itinerary: US\$185 per person.

These government port fees/taxes and national park fees may change at the discretion of port authorities.

+ PAYMENT METHODS

The following payment methods are accepted: Mastercard, Visa, American Express and Diners International, as well as bank transfers, Paypal (payment in US dollars) and Transbank (payment in Chilean pesos).

+ RESERVATIONS, DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS

A US\$300 deposit per person is required to secure a reservation. Full payment of the ticket price must be received by the Company no later than 60 days* prior to departure.

*This payment deadline does not apply to promotions and/or special trips.

+ CANCELLATION POLICY

The reservation can be canceled:

- Up to 120 days before departure without incurring any penalties, in which case the Company will refund the total value of what was received as at the date of cancellation.
- From the 119th day prior to departure, incurring the following penalties:
 - (i) Between 119 and 60 days (both inclusive) before departure: US\$300, value of the deposit.
 - (ii) Between 59 and 50 days (both inclusive) before departure: 25% of the value of the reservation.
 - (iii) Between 49 and 40 days (both inclusive) before departure: 50% of the value of the reservation.
 - (iv) Between 39 and 30 days (both inclusive) before departure: 75% of the value of the reservation.
 - (v) From the 29th (inclusive) before departure: 100% of the value of the reservation.

The corresponding penalties will be applied as soon as the Company receives notification of cancellation in writing.

PRICING CONDITIONS

FOR THE 2027 - 2028 SEASON

+ SPECIAL RATES

- RATES FOR SOLO TRAVELLERS: Available on all cabin types and applies an additional 50% to the corresponding published rate.
- RATES FOR BABIES: Up to 3 years of age, 100% discount, sharing bed with parents. Please contact us regarding availability of cribs.
- RATES FOR CHILDREN: Children from 4 to 12 years of age, 50% discount when sharing cabin with an adult.
- EXTRA BED: An extra bed can be added to double cabins. Please contact us for rates and availability.

+ CRUISE CANCELLATION

The Company may cancel one or more voyages due to force majeure or acts of God, i.e., the measures imposed by the national authorities in the port of departure or landfall that prevent the departure or landfall and/or the restrictions imposed by the national or international authorities that restrict or prevent the access of passengers to the port of departure or from carrying out cruise voyages for leisure purposes. In the event of the cancellation of a trip for any of the above mentioned reasons, the Company shall only be obliged to reimburse the value of the amount paid for the reservation, being deemed understood that any indemnity action for any reason, including consequential damages, loss of profit or moral damages, has been waived by the mere fact of making the reservation. The waiver shall also apply in case of the rescheduling of the voyage.

+ REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

It will be the responsibility of the passenger to have all the necessary documentation required by relevant authorities to enter the countries of

embarkation and disembarkation, as well as to the port cities, which must be shown to Australis if requested. Due to the Australis itineraries that involve the entering/departing to/from Argentina, passengers are responsible for holding valid travel insurance that meets the requirements set by the relevant authorities and for presenting proof of such insurance at check-in. Failure to provide this documentation will result in a denial of boarding.

+ NOTE

The trips described in the itineraries are usually possible. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Company reserves the right to alter, change or disregard part of this itinerary without prior notice, whether motivated by the welfare and safety of passengers, for the proper preservation of the environment or due to any extraordinary circumstance, fortuitous event or force majeure. Furthermore, the departure or arrival of vessels may be subject to possible changes. Thus, it is not possible to guarantee bird and animal sightings, since the precise location may change.
